

Primary Intervention Rating Scale Report

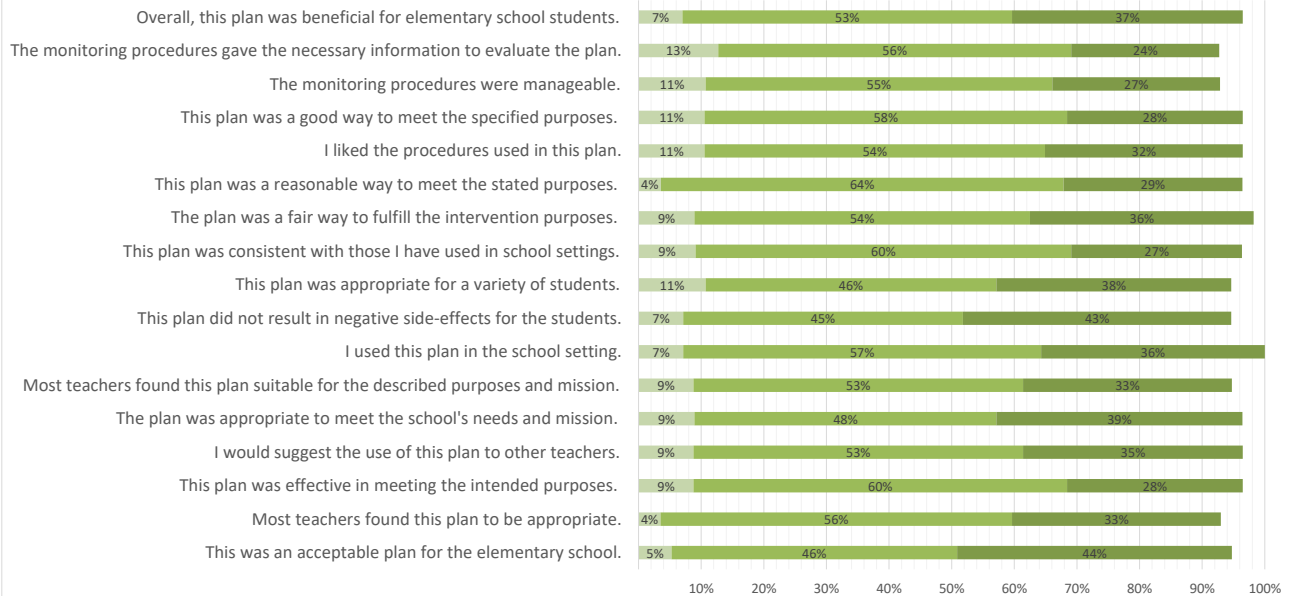

Most beneficial was rewarding students for following the behavior expectations. Least beneficial was when teachers used the system incorrectly and handed tickets out for things that are not part of behavior expectations like holding the door open for someone.
